Torsionally stiff enough to grip on the nasty stuff, combined with a supple flex to follow the contours of varied terrain.

Turns are at the will of the skier and require simple edging skills, which in turn send the Sensation into smooth controlled arcs.

The 17 meter radius (at 178cm) while not legal for FIS candidates, is perfect for All Mountain cruising at blistering speeds but doesn't restrict the skis ability to make some pretty nice shorter arcs.

The definitive "Club Racer" ski; fast and they don't drift out of the turn, even at "hair on fire" speed.
