

Rossignol Avenger 82 Carbon

The Rossignol Avenger 82 has the high-speed agility of a carving ski with the versatility & stability of a free-ride ski. Excels in both short and long radius turns. 60% Frontside/40% Backside. The lighter of the two Avengers, the 82 Carbon melds traditional ski construction with modern all-mountain dimensions to create a high-performance machine sure to be loved by aggressive skiers. Ideal for expert-level skiers who seek a powerful experience on versatile skis. from the groomed runs to powder. A Wood core sandwiched between 2 layers of Carbon creates a light and lively ski with excellent ski-to-snow feel and superb damping characteristics. 2 layers of a carbon laminate increase overall rigidity of skis and make for one fast, stable ride. Our test team LOVED this ski and its bigger brother the Avenger 82 Ti, so the toughest decision is "which one is for me?"

We'll help with that and the first factors to consider should be the skiers weight, and the desired turn shapes. Big guys, might want to look to the Ti version; same profile . . . a little more motor.

Rossignol Avenger 72

The new Avenger 72 is simply a wonderfully smooth all-mountain ride, especially if the majority of your time is spent charging the blacks. Much like the Rossi 4S/7S in its day, the 72 Avenger is all the good stuff in one ski and Rossi has produced a great ski with true high performance all mountain capabilities.
